


## EXPLANATION OF THE THEME



The European Union of the Deaf Youth is a European non-profit organization whose membership comprises the Youth National Associations of the Deaf and Youth Section of National Associations of Deaf people in Europe. Established in 1987, EUDY is the only organization representing the interests of Deaf Youth living in Europe. EUDY strives to foster the personal development of young Deaf persons with sign language in Europe and to further mutual understanding to advance and protect the rights of Deaf people and opportunities for young Deaf people in Europe. The diversity and inclusion is also part of the EUDY guidelines.



The Austrian Deaf Youth Commission (= ÖGLB Jugendkommission) was formed in 2005. Its goals are to unite Austrians deaf and hard of hearing youth nationwide, whilst also providing a space with no language barriers. The Commission has a strong Austrian sign language foundation and is welcoming everyone regarding their level of hearing loss and background. At the moment there are four young members advocating for their community. Each member has different strengths and experience. They work together so youths can find and strengthen their identity and connect with peers without being discriminated against or undermined.



There are some important guidelines about seeking a leader. Leaders must be Deaf. They should be aged minimum from 21 but we recommend 35. They should be fluent in International Sign and know their sign language in their own country. They have previous experience working at camps or with children. The leader's task is to take care of children from their country. A leader accompanies them on arrival and departure and makes sure that all participants are enjoying themselves at camp. They will be able to work in a team with leaders from other countries and are primarily responsible for their campers. Of course, they will also participate in activities during the camp.

 A meeting with leaders before the camp:  
Before the camp, there will be a mandatory meeting via Zoom between leaders and the OC team via Zoom. The date for the meeting and the Zoom link will be announced in April 2023.


## CAMP FEES



## MEDIA POLICY

During the camp we will have a media team who will be responsible for the pictures and the video report: Fuming and Elza. We strongly feel the privacy of the participants and the leaders should be respected. This is why we have installed a media policy. Taking pictures of the participants and leaders is not allowed. 


## THE USE OF PHONES

Even though the use of smartphones and Wi-Fi is immensely popular, we feel this can interfere with the program. That is why all the leaders will collect the phones of their juniors and keep them stored during the whole camp, except for the free time. The leaders will give the phones back when the free time starts and collect it again as soon it finishes. And at the party on the last day before departure, the participants can have their phone back. The leaders are allowed to keep their own phones and to use it throughout the day to keep in contact with the parents of the children or the COC. But please do not let it interfere with your leader duties.




## EUDY'S ALCOHOL AND DRUG POLICIES

Consumption of alcohol and drugs is absolutely prohibited for the entire duration of the camp. Any participant under the age of 18 is NOT permitted to smoke. Also if you have permission from your parents, you cannot smoke. Medicine prescribed by the doctor is allowed if you bring a doctor's note with an explanation. Parental permission is required for bringing or buying over-the-counter medicine.


## THE HANDBOOK
